


User Guide for HUD Low Mod Block Groups Viewer Application

How to get to HUD Maps:

1. In your browser type in <https://www.hudexchange.info/programs/acs-low-mod-summary-data/>
2. Under Data Sets (Right hand side of the page), click **Map Applications**
3. At the Low- and Moderate-Income Summary Data, based on 2011-2015 ACS webpage on the right hand side of the page, click View Application

How to use HUD Maps

1. ZOOM IN and DATA Will Appear. Use the text search, navigation controls, or mouse scroll wheel to zoom in to the activity's service area.
2. Click the LAYER ICON and leave only one LMISD Layer checked
3. Use SELECT TOOL to pick geographies that match the service area of the activity.
 - ✓ Viewing LMI Data in Pop-Up: In the map, CLICK on the geography, and a pop-up window will provide the LMI data for the active geographies, OR
 - ✓ Exporting LMI Data: In the select tool window, CLICK ●●● (to the right of the chosen layer). The pop-up window will show a variety of options, including: Export csv and Attribute Table. The Attribute Table is also available by clicking the small arrow in the bottom middle of the
